Some of our areas currently have a no-visitor policy

Please **do not** visit wards if you have had fever, cough, sore throat, or runny nose in the past 24 hours.

Children under 16 will not be able to visit, unless there is a clear medical need or exceptional circumstance.

No visitors are allowed in:

- Special Care Baby Unit (SCBU)
- Ata Rangi (maternity birthing unit, Hawke's Bay Hospital)
- Waioha (primary birthing unit, Hawke's Bay Hospital)
- · Wairoa maternity ward
- Children's ward, Hawke's Bay Hospital

Exception: parents/guardians can support a child in hospital.

Emergency department is limited to 1 support person per patient.

Ward A1 visiting is limited to 1 visitor per patient, once a day only.

Intensive Care Unit (ICU) visiting is limited to 2 visitors per patient, once a day only.

- Visitors to any area of our facilities may be asked to wear a mask or other protective wear.
- The decision about whether exceptional circumstances apply is at the Charge Nurse Manager's or another lead clinician's discretion.
