I refer to your Official Information Act request dated 8 June 2020 where you requested information from Hawke's Bay District Health Board (HBDHB). Your questions and HBDHB's response is provided below:

Please provide me with a table with the number of people working in COVID-19 contact tracing for each day from 1 December 2019 to 31 May 2020.

Hawke's Bay DHB is not able to provide a daily figure. However, the DHB can provide an indicative Full Time Equivilant (FTE) monthly figure for staff rostered to work on COVID-19 contact tracing only for between December 2019 and May 2020. Please note, however, the table below does not include staff who were also working on COVID-19 case investigation, welfare and all other aspects of the DHB's response to COVID-19. Hawke's Bay DHB's public health unit also utilised the support of the National Contact Tracing Centre (NCTC) during this time, when needed.

Month	Number of FTE undertaking COVID-19 contact tracing ONLY

Jan 2020	0.4
Feb 2020	0.6
Mar 2020	3.5
April 2020	7
May 2020	5.5

Note: FTE equates to a full time person employed for 40 hours per week
